

Stripe Coating And Finger Lift

TamperTech manufacture a wide range of tamper evident Labels and Tapes which means we know a thing or two about glue...

Because of this we are able to use a technique called stripe coating, this can come in many forms for Dead centre's on our labels to finger-lifts.

A dead centre is where there is no adhesive applied to the centre of a label, this can be helpful for a variety of reasons including, security cuts to break easily when a door, drawer, cupboard etc are opened to speciality labels like our dumbbell labels that are designed to seal anything from a test tube to a wine bottle without getting adhesive on the top of the opening to stop contamination.

Finger lifts are where a label's edges don't have adhesive on so that they are easier to apply by hand without the worry of getting adhesive on your hands whilst applying them making it easier and more efficient when apply them by hand.
